Clay Clark Show with Doug Macaffey

Clay: [\(00:49:15\)](#):

Gentlemen. Welcome aboard. A flight was 0 2 0 2 0 0 6 0 6 0 6. I'm your captain, Bill Gates and to my right and my co-pilot Klaus Schwab of The World Economic Forum. And you'll be free to move around the cabin as long as you take RNA modifying nanotechnology, graphene oxide, and fetal tissue cell line filled Covid 19 vaccines. But then you still, you need to wear a mask...

(Voice): Excuse me! While eat, can I take off my mask? I want to eat snacks.)

Sir, you just need to sit down right now and just calm down. Okay. You're going to have to wear a mask while you eat the snack. (Voice): I can't eat my snack while I'm wearing my mask!

All right, Thrive Nation. Many of you from coast to coast. And I say many. I don't know, JT, we've probably had hundreds of people that have reached out to airline workers, employees of airlines, that say, "I do not want to take the RNA, modifying, nanotechnology filled, graphene oxide, technology COVID-19 vaccines." They did. They don't want to take the vaccines, but yet the airlines are being, are telling their employees, "If you don't take the vaccine by a certain date, you're going to lose your job." And so we've, we've got to a breaking point where something has to give. And so I reached out to a very reputable attorney in Tulsa, Oklahoma, and I said, would you be willing to help the, the listeners of our show, the airline employees, put together some, some type of airline injunction against COVID-19 vaccines. And I wanted to reach out to a very reputable attorney who had been recommended to me by multiple people. And that's how we ended up on the phone here with Doug, and then through a series of poor life choices. Doug said, I'm in, I'm willing to fight for these people. So Doug Mahaffey welcome onto the Thrive Time Show. How are you, sir?

Now, Doug, for anybody out there who doesn't know about your background and just briefly, can you share with the listeners out there about your, your brief legal background so people can understand a little bit about your credibility?

Doug: [\(00:51:18\)](#):

Yeah, sure. So, I started practicing law in 1986 Clay. I graduated from Pepperdine Law School, which is a faith-based law school. I went to a faith-based college in Texas, and I started my own practice in 1990 and really have become a federal court litigation specialists, meaning that I do practice in state court as well. I'm licensed in California. I practice in states all over the country and federal litigation cases. Federal courts, of course, are where this type of a case involving American Airlines is going to be venued. It's going to ultimately determine where each of the individuals lives probably as to whether or not there's one or multiple cases, but federal court is who has jurisdiction over federal laws. And that's why we file federal actions just because we're enforcing federal laws. So that's been an extensive part of my background, lots of different class actions, multi complex actions. Usually it's the David Goliath scenario. I have a small firm compared to these multi-million dollar, large firm groups that we go against. But what I find is that if you're an aggressive litigator and you know how to get through the court system, at the end of the day, it's one lawyer versus another. They may have a team of 20, but I'll take them all on. And I've been doing that my whole career.

Clay: (00:52:31):

And if you've been doing it pretty successfully throughout the years. I mean, do you win, you know, 10% of the time, do you win 2% of the time? What's, what's your average?

Doug: (00:52:40):

No, no. I would have to guess, I'd say 90% of the cases that I have taken to verdict, I win completely. I have taken a lot of cases where the other side falls right before a verdict, and I've had a lot of cases dismissed when I'm defending him. So I have a high percentage rate, a lot of that's just simply knowing how to navigate the procedures of the federal and state court system and understanding how to litigate.

Clay: (00:53:03):

Now, what, why JTS here with us today, why I'm here is JT is sort of like a boots on the ground, in the trenches. He's talking to, in our team, our entire call center team, we're talking to, I mean, how many people per day, JT, are calling because they're concerned about their employer forcing the COVID-19 vaccines? How many per day, do you think?

JT: 20 minimum.

Clay: And that's just JT and there's, you know, six or seven call reps. We're talking about 140 people every day. And so what I'm going to do, Doug, is I'm just going to kind of ask some questions on behalf of our listeners who want to get involved. So step number one, if people want to get involved in the airline injunction action against the COVID-19 vaccines, we're putting a button on the website as of October 11th. So if you're hearing this on October 10th, you have to wait until October 11th.

Clay: (00:53:51):

And on October 11th you're going to go to TimeToFreeAmerican.com. And you're going to click the button, look for the button. You just look for the airplane and the button that says, "want to join the airline injunction against the COVID-19 vaccine mandates? (question, mark) click that button. And when you click that button, what you have to do next, step two, is you have to actually put your information, you have to put your name, your phone number and your email into a form and click submit. From that point forward, what needs to happen next there, sir? What does our, what do our listeners need to do if they want to participate?

Doug: (00:54:26):

Yeah. So every American Airline employee, whether they're a pilot, a steward, whether they work in the cargo bay, wherever their employment relationship is with American, needs to fill out the form so that they can become a client of Mahaffey Law Group. That'll be the primary firm handling this. My firm out of California and Tulsa will associate with other attorneys that also will help us with broadening the team. But for me to have conversations with them about the basis of their unique circumstance, maybe they've got a religious exemption, maybe they've got a medical exemption. Maybe they just simply don't want to inject their body with something they don't have enough confidence in. There's a myriad of different circumstances. And so for me to have those conversations, they need to not only fill out the form, then we'll send them our fee agreement and they'll have to sign that, fill out the information and send the \$500 retainer check. So the whole basis of this game plan is to get as many employees together, \$500 per employee. We need to raise at least 50,000. So that's a hundred employees. Got... obviously we can get more than that, then we'll be on our way. We need experts. We got to line up a lot of information to go to the emergency setting to block this mandate.

Clay: (00:55:43):

And I have got doctors, I mean, dozens of doctors and attorneys that are willing to expert, willing to testify, whistleblowers within Pfizer, other organizations willing to testify. So I, I feel very good about the experts. And again, I'm just going ask some rude questions on behalf of the people who would want to ask you the question. You know, what is the \$500 go to, you know how that is? Somebody out there is asking the question, Doug, you know, what's this money being used to, are you buying koozies that say Douglas Mahaffey on it? I mean, what's the money going to be used for?

Doug: ([00:56:12](#)):

Yeah. So this is going to be a hard fought litigation case. And so there's three categories of expenses: category one are just the court filing fees. So this money will be used to pay the initial fees to the federal court system. And, or we may have to file administrative proceedings with the EDOC. Category Two: is to fund the attorney team, all the attorneys that work on this we'll have various hourly rates depending on their experience level. They'll either work for me as employees or independent contractors or associates, and they'll get paid hourly. Category three: is just simply the expert expenses that are incurred with all the doctors and scientists who would need to be flown out for the hearings as well as paid their expenses for their hourly work. So there's three categories the money goes to.

Clay: ([00:56:58](#)):

So let's re recap here. So, so step one, if you want to get involved here, you have to click the button on TimeToFreeAmerica, that TimeToFreeAmerica.com, TimeToFreeAmerica.com. And JT, I'm going to see if I can show you where it is, and then you make sure... I'm going to make sure I'm clarifying this; everybody gets this because if... there's no bad listeners or just bad communicators or bad hosts. So if we go to TimeToFreeAmerica.com, there's buttons that could go across the website, we're going to click the button that says, want to join the airline and junction against the COVID-19 vaccine mandates. We're going to put our name, our phone number, our email in there. Then we're going to have a form that's going to get kicked to you via email. And, Doug, will you accept credit cards? Could they fill out credit cards or would they have to mail you a check, sir?

Doug: ([00:57:41](#)):

No, we can, if they have a credit card information, we can fill those out and run those through a Square Account. There's a small fee of course, for that, for the Square company, not us, but we can process it that way. So we're placing all that money into an attorney, client trust account. (Got it.) And so once we get enough people signed up, then we'll start issuing statements as we incur the expenses. So people can account for it.

Clay: ([00:58:03](#)):

JT. What question would you have on behalf of our listeners? Cause you're talking to more of our listeners than I am. One question, would you have on behalf of the listeners who do not want to take the COVID-19 vaccine, vaccines in order to keep their job at their airline?

JT: ([00:58:15](#)):

Yeah. Well, first I have a question about helping raise money for that. So say I'm somebody and I'm seeing this happen. And I know this is a big case and it'll help with other cases to come because it's going to be with more employees. If I'm not an actual employee of one of these airlines, can I donate money to help you fund?

Doug: ([00:58:33](#)):

Yeah. So what we'll probably end up doing on, that's a great question, is that we work with a number of nonprofits and what will probably happen is because there's a very large religious exemption affiliation with nonprofits, like with American faith.com, for example, is we will work in a way to channel those donations so they get a tax-free donation. They may be able to donate to one of Clay's nonprofits and then that nonprofit in support of the religious exemptions, which is of course one of three categories, can then fund it. So that's how that will happen. Lawyers can't take money from people who aren't clients, but nonprofits fund litigation expenses all day long that are aligned with their nonprofit purpose. So we'll manage that.

Clay: ([00:59:15](#)):

Now, just for clarity folks, if you're out there today and you're going well, what do I do now? While you're listening to this show? Because so far, if you're keeping score, JT has asked much better questions than me thus far. So JT, what final question would you have for Doug before we give Doug the final word?

Yeah. So if I'm an airline employee and I want to be a part of this, how does... do I have to show my face? Do I have to, is there a way to do it anonymously? Or how do I speak out and start helping? And do I have to fly to you? There's a lot of questions for it.

Doug: [\(01:00:17\)](#):

Yeah, no. If you're going to sign up as an employee, then you're going to have to become a client that probably will be listed on the lawsuit. However, one of the objectives is to do what's called "a class action of like situated plaintiffs," meaning employees. So for example, everyone who does business for American Airline in Texas, everyone who does business in Oklahoma, Florida. So as we canvas the nation with your residents, we may be able to include you not as a name plaintiff, but as what we call a putative plaintiff fancy word, that simply means we're representing you, but you're unnamed as a class member. So that's a complex analysis. So we have the courageous, if you will, who stand up first, their names go on the pleading. Then we say to the judge, looks, we want to put everybody in Oklahoma together, everybody in Texas together as a class group, because they're all the same. And then you can fall into that mix and help fund for your other co-employees, the fight.

Doug, I guess my, my final question for you, or I guess where I'd like to leave, to conclude this interview is: what are the questions that maybe I'm not asking or what are some clarifying information that you want to communicate to the millions of listeners out there that are undoubtedly wanting to take action immediately? What else needs to be stated so that people can turn this knowledge into action?

Doug: [\(01:01:35\)](#):

Well, time is of the essence. I mean, for starters. I understand this mandate goes into effect in mid-November. I think it's November 21st I've heard. That means by then, those who are not exempted by virtue of the conditions of it, and each condition, each company's different, are going to lose pay. So they basically are effectively terminated because they're given an unpaid leave. So to stop that, we have about six weeks, to put together a team of not only experts in testimony, but navigate the complex federal system, to be able to get a judge, either in Texas, Oklahoma, or another state, to stop it for its residents. So we may have to file this in multiple states before they consolidate them. So the point is, is that if you were an American employee and you're thinking about this and you don't want to go on medical leave, quote, you don't want to go on unpaid leave quote, where you don't get paid because you refuse to take this vaccine, we need to get started. And so I need all the information, I've already reached out to get the exact emails, the protocols that have been provided by American airlines, what they say and don't say, and their human resource policy, we've got to get all that together, scour it, assemble it and get it in front of a judge in an organized way. So this thing is going to have to move and I need everyone to sign up or we don't have enough horsepower to do it.
